

To the parents of a child newly diagnosed with leukaemia there are so many questions--what caused the illness, what does the treatment involve, and crucially, will my child fully recover? The difficulties in coping and getting on with everyday life both during and after the illness, remain just as great, whether treatment is successful or not. Even years after the treatment, there are concerns about the possibility of recurrence. More recently growing attention has been focused on the increasing number of long-term survivors. Will their leukaemia return after many years? Are they at increased risk of other cancers? Should they have children? Will their children get leukaemia?
